Call to Order

There was discussion on the additional insulation added to the Sale Barn and the renovation of the Sale Barn swamp coolers. Mike Sager moved to hold on to the quote from Rocky Mountain Portable Cooling until the committee had a chance to evaluate how effective the renovated swamp coolers worked in the heat.
